SeniorsUnited is powered by people, not corporations or lobbyists. We believe in full transparency when it comes to contributions and spending.

For now, we'll be honest: **we don't have much to show yet.** As a new grassroots, all-volunteer nonprofit (501(c)(4)), we are just beginning our journey.

At this early stage, SeniorsUnited is personally funded by our founder to cover startup costs. This ensures we launch with full independence before inviting grassroots supporters to contribute.

What you can expect here in the future:

- Annual Contribution Totals – how much we raise each year.
- Donor Participation – number of individual contributors and average gift size.
- Funding Sources – a breakdown of contributions (and a clear statement that we accept no corporate PAC or lobbyist money).
- Spending Summary – how contributions are used to power programs, technology, and outreach.

When will this be available?

Our fiscal year ends on **December 31st**. Consistent with IRS rules, our first annual contribution summary will be posted here in **2026** and updated annually thereafter.
