- Harassment or Personal Attacks No bullying, insults, threats, or targeting of individuals or groups.
- **Disinformation** Do not post or spread false, misleading, or manipulated content.

- **Spam or Promotion** SeniorsUnited is not a marketplace; avoid promotional or repetitive content.
- Hate Speech or Discrimination Zero tolerance for attacks on identity, background, or belief.
- **Disruptive Behavior** Any actions that undermine the safety, trust, or purpose of the community.
